ORDER:

The Additional Advocate General in the reference 2nd read above has informed that the Hon'ble High Court in Writ Appeal No.1063 of 2012 filed by the Government and AFRC against the order of the single Judge in W.P. No.26418 of 2012 dt: 24-08-2012 have passed the following orders:-

"Therefore, it appears to u s that the criteria has been given in the said order specifically made it clear that the undertakings to be filed before the Court and on furnishing such undertakings within one week thereafter to AFRC with complete details / figures to evaluate the financial burden so to be borne by the inistitutions. Such being the position, we think that it would be proper at this stage for us to direct the respondent – colleges / institutions to furnish such undertakings before this Court by tomorrow (29-08-2012) stating that they have already given effect to 1996 pay scales in terms of the Supreme Court order and also the particulars as mentioned therein. The amount so directed by the Hon'ble Single Judge shall be liable to be collected the same as fees subject to result of the Special Leave Petitions before the Hon'ble Supreme Court and subject to the undertakings as directed by us in this order.

Accordingly, we direct the State Government to take necessary further steps in the matter, preferably by tomorrow (29-08-2012).

The writ appeal is accordingly disposed of No costs."

The Addl. Advocate General has also informed that (13) colleges have filed three writ petitions i.e., W.P.No.26916, 27055 and 27049 of 2012 and the Hon'ble single Judge disposed of the writ petitions in terms of the judgement in W.A.No.1063 of 2012, dt: 24-08-2012. He has further informed that as per the orders passed by the Division Bench and Learned single Judge undertakings along with affidavits have been received from (18) colleges. However one college by name Nawab Shah Alam Khan College of Engineering, Hyderabad which has filed an affidavit of undertaking to notify of Rs.50200/- before the Hon'ble Court is already included in Annexure-I A of the reference 1st read above and hence notifying the lesser fee for the said college may not be proper and hence this college may be continued under Annexure-I A itself.

In view of the above, the Addl. Advocate General has opined that as per the orders of the Division Bench and the learned single Judge the fee for (17) colleges those which have given undertakings along with affidavits will have to
